Time: 6pm to 7.30pm

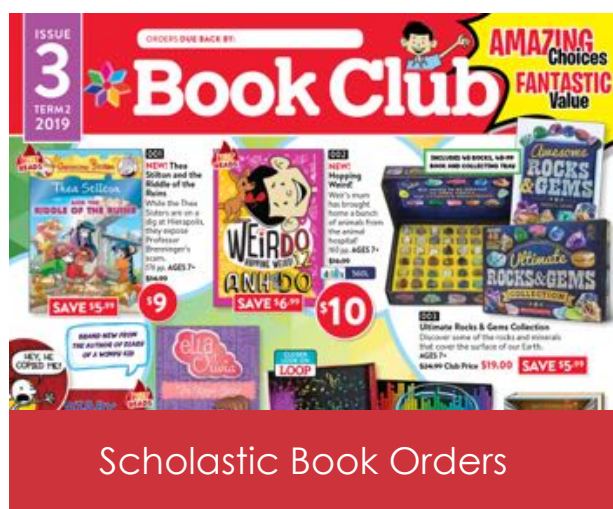
