News From Nelson Intermediate

As you may be aware, Hugh Gully resigned from his position as principal of Nelson Intermediate at the end of Term 1 this year to take up a position in Golden Bay. This left the principal position free. The new principal is Di Webb. Di is excited about her new position and is enjoying the challenge of working in a new school after her time at Hampden Street as deputy principal.

The Board of Trustees at Nelson Intermediate have made a recent change in their class structure for 2020 and have sent the following information for students and whanau for 2020 and beyond:

Nelson Intermediate Board of Trustees is excited to announce that after much discussion and research Nelson Intermediate, from 2020 will no longer have the option of an extension class in Year 7, and from 2021 there will be no extension classes. Every classroom and teacher provides an extension and an enrichment programme to ensure that all students are engaged and are developing student agency.

To further enhance learning and a sense of belonging, Nelson Intermediate will be composite Year 7 & 8 from 2020. This is with the exception of the Year 8 extension class for 2020 only. Research shows that student learning and success is based on strong relationships with the classroom teacher. This philosophy is also supported by many of our contributing primary schools which in-turn supports a robust transition programme; and the Kāhui Ako ki Whakatū vision of building collaboration to enhance engagement and achievement for all learners so that our young people have equitable life choices.

Personally I think both these decisions are very good, are in line with research and are very definitely in the best interests of students and their learning.

Teaching of Maths at Clifton Terrace School and Across the Kahui Ako.

You will be aware that Clifton Terrace works as a partner in the Kāhui Ako ki Whakatū (Nelson Community of Schools). We continue to meet regularly and are forging fantastic collaborative relationships across our schools which includes our secondary colleagues at Nelson College and Nelson College for Girls.

One piece of work we are all collaborating on is DMIC (Developing Mathematical Inquiry Communities). This work is looking at how we are teaching maths in our schools and has involved some rethinking of our programmes. This piece of work will be undertaken over three years.
